Nature of support during 2015/2016

- Individualised support through 1:1 or small group tuition: targeted support from our part-time teacher to address misconceptions, gaps, areas for development in order to further support them in meeting their targets and age related expectations
- Pupil Premium and Pupil Premium Plus Pupils are regularly tracked as a specific group with progress and attainment monitored closely in relation to their peers.
- Individualised support: targeted support with teaching assistants to extend children's writing, maths or grammar skills or to receive specific intervention programmes eg. Rapid Reading / Maths.
- Financial support to families to ensure pupils have opportunities for extra-curricular and residential activities

Impact of Pupil Premium Spending - to be completed April 2016

- Pupils were able to access residential activities and outdoor and adventurous activities. Pupils report increased confidence and self-esteem through activities and time away.
- Increased confidence in pupils from attending small group / 1:1 intervention groups
- One pupil premium child has since left the school.
- As of March 2016, 75% of pupil premium pupils are Meeting Age Related Expectation in Reading, Writing and Maths.
- As of March 2016 75% of pupil premium pupils are making expected progress in reading writing and maths and 50% are making better than expected progress.
