Nature of support during 2014/2015

- Pupil Premium and Pupil Premium Plus Pupils are regularly tracked as a specific group with progress and attainment monitored closely in relation to their peers.
- Individualised support through 1:1 or small group tuition: targeted support from our part-time teacher to address misconceptions, gaps, areas for development in order to further support them in meeting their targets and age related expectations
- Individualised support: targeted support with teaching assistants to extend children's writing, maths or grammar skills or to receive specific intervention programmes eg. Rapid Reading / Maths.
- Financial support to families to ensure pupils have opportunities for extra-curricular and residential activities
- Provision of specific ICT equipment and software to support and extend pupils learning in different curriculum areas

Impact of Pupil Premium Spending

- Targeted intervention resulted in increased confidence, attitude and learning of pupils involved.
- School data indicates that all pupils eligible for Pupil Premium funding make at least expected and in some cases accelerated progress in reading, writing and maths.
- In 2014 at KS2 100% of pupils eligible (in Y6) achieved Level 4 + in reading, writing and maths; this placed them above their peers nationally.
- Specific interventions led to increased rates of progress for the majority of our pupil premium pupils
